





#### EXTENDING THE STALE' LINE

**Backgrou**nd: The notary records sent by Bro. Cena continue to provide names of those who are beyond the veil. At present we have not been able to connect these people to our Cardon Stallé Line. However through more research, it is possible they are our relatives.

The wife of Pietro Stale' who was born about 1643 and died before 10 Nov. 1672 was Maria Benech, daughter of Gioanni Benech. Maria had a sister Margarita married to Samuel Grasso, another sister Madalena was married to Pietro Riviore, and she had a brother Giacomo, but no spouse was listed. These have now been entered into Family Search.


