



In LSG-05 PG 264 dated 2 Apr 1623 Ugonetto Stale had a daughter named Maria. Ugonetto Stallé is the 5th great uncle of Susette Stallé. Although we have not yet found the direct relationship, Gioanetto Stallé is from the same town of Angrogna. In ANGROGNA vol. 139 libro 14; pg. 14R it indicates Gioanetto Stallé's father was Gioanni and he had a son Daniele who was married to Maria Arbarea, the daughter of Gioanetto Arbarea. In Angrogna vol 139 pg 44 dated 2 Apr 1623, it indicates that Margarita Perone, daughter of deceased Martino Perone, and the widow Gioanetto Stallé; had a grandson, Gioanni, the son of her deceased son Michele, and she also had daughters: Madalena and Maria (wife of Gioanni MARCHETO) and she had grandchildren: Margarita, Anna and Suzanna children of her son Danielle. Temple work for Margarita was done under "Mrs. Gioanetto Stallé.
