International Reunion Next Year (2000) in the Waldensian Valleys

All those of Malan descent—Cardons as well as Malans—are invited to the International Malan Reunion in the Waldensian Valleys. The specific reunion dates are 22 through 25 June 2000, headquartered at the Gilly Hotel in Torre Pellice (La Tour). The Gilly Hotel is managed by Mario Malan.

This presents the opportunity of a lifetime to visit the actual villages where our ancestors were born, married, and died—and where some joined the LDS Church. Arrangements have been made with the Waldensian Church for tours.

Options are being explored for visiting additional sites, such as areas in Switzerland (such as Geneva, Lausanne, Morges) where our ancestors lived as exiles (and where some of them married Swiss mates).

The reunion was suggested by the Malan family organization of South Africa (which now numbers over 7,000 blood descendants of the original settler). In addition to the U.S. and South Africa, it is anticipated that Malan descendants will attend from Italy, France, the Netherlands, the UK, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Brazil, and Uruguay.

Highlights from the notarial records continue here. Because so many of the surnames appear on the pedigress of our separate families, we present them in alphabetical order. This avoids having to repeat the entries for each immigrant surname. We also present the extractions by separate volume number to simplify the reports. To conserve space, we list only those persons mentioned in any given act whose relationship to the particular surname is specified. Numbers in parentheses indicate the page number in the volume and the date of the act.
