We continue here our notarial records highlights. *Because so many of the surnames appear on the pedigrees of our separate families, we present them in alphabetical order. This avoids having to repeat them. We also present the extractions by separate volume to simplify the reports.*

Numbers in parentheses indicate the page number in the volume and the date of the act. NOTE: The year attached to the volume number is when the notary officially *deposited* the record—not necessarily the year in which the original record was made. Sometimes it is the same year, but often the notary (because he had to pay a fee each time) delayed registering some acts.

Details of International Malan Reunion in Valleys

Estimated cost of airfare, leaving Salt Lake City on June 15 to Geneva, thence to Torino on June 21, and returning either on June 26 from Milan or June 29 from Rome: \$865 per person. Estimated accommodations at the Gilly Hotel in Torino (managed by Mario Malan): \$42 per person per day. Other Waldensian descendants may wish to substitute visits to their own ancestral villages. Proposed reunion plan:

Thursday, June 22: (Optional) Hike over the Cottian Alps from France to Bobbio Pellice (rigorous; route our ancestors took); (alternate) Visit other ancestral villages in the Valleys; official opening, including overview of Waldensian history by Waldensian representative.

Friday, June 23: Visit the Angrogna Valley, including the 500-year-old Waldensian Seminary; the Waldensian Church at Pra del Tour; Serre Malan; the hamlet of Malano; Chanforan (where the Waldensian Church formally voted in 1532 to join the Reformation); and the Chiesa della Tana, hiding place of Waldensians for centuries.

Saturday, June 24: Visit the Waldensian Museum, Torre Pellice, and villages of St Martin and St Jean (San Giovanni).

Sunday, June 25: Religious services together; formal closure of Reunion.
