We haven't extracted records for all the villages in that area, but Brother Cena has already begun extracting records from the jurisdiction across the mountains. Most (if not all) of our families have ancestors from Prarostina, Roccapiatta, and other adjacent villages. And these villages have an even higher percentage of Waldensians than San Giovanni.

A Visit with Our Researcher

Lou Cardon, a distant Waldensian cousin who (with his wife Robin) is serving a temple mission in Switzerland, has met our researcher, Giovanni Cena.

They have met at least twice when the Cenas have gone to the temple. In addition, when the temple was closed for cleaning this summer, Lou and Robin traveled to the Waldensian Valleys. Lou was very impressed with the Cenas and their four children. He describes Brother Cena as bright, humble, and dependable.

A Summary of Cardon References in San Giovanni by Boyd Cardon

I have found twenty-five or more **CARDON** names in 37 of the analyzed Luserna San Giovanni records. (Italian: **CARDONE**, **CARDONATO** [a variant of Cardon]).

Volume 3 (1613) Purchase: Gioanni Cardone(1) son of the deceased Peijretto Cardone(2) of Roccapiatta p 568; Gioanni(3) son of deceased Mateo Cardone (4), also mentions Filippo Cardone(5) p 568.

Volume 7 (1617) Quittance: Maria Cardone(6) dau. of deceased Michele Cardone(7) p 239 md Gioanni Bianco.

Volume 17 (1627) Quittance: Giacomo Cardone(8) and Giorgio Cardone(9)(brothers) sons of deceased Michele Cardone(10) p 257.

Volume 22(1634-35) Purchase: Virginia Cardone (11) widow of Giome Brianza daughter of deceased Gaspardo Cardone(Cardonato)(12) of San Segundo p 86

Volume 26(1642) Purchase: Martari?Cardone(13) & Margarita Cardone(14) sisters of dec.Paijretto Cardone(15) of Roccapiatta p. 117; Purchase: Simonino Cardone(16) dead by 1640 mentions wid. Agnette who remarried Gapardo Moresco. p 385

Volume 31(1653) Will and testimony: Felicia Cardonato(17), Gerolamo Cardonato(18), and Francesca-Maria Cardonato(20) sisters and brother. Father's given name is not given. p85

Volume 33 (1657) Purchase: Daniele Cardone(21) son of the deceased Michele Cardone(22) of Roccapiatta; mentions Daniele's wife, Maria Rolle p 149R

Volume 53(1700) Sell: Gioanni-Battista Cardone (24), a deaf mute 60 yrs old and his brother Gioanni(25) sons of deceased Gioanni(26) Cardon from San Segundo p 189; Will of Margarita Cardone (27) daughter of deceased David Cardone(28) promised as a wife to Giacomo Pachetto p228R

Senato Papers of San Giovanni Luserna Mazzo [Batch] 97 [Claims of Returning Exiles]

Margarita Cardone(23), wife of Pietro Chianforano and lists children as Giuseppe and Maria p209

Comments: (2) and (15) may be the same person; also (7) and (10) are the same person. Perhaps (22) is the same as (7).

This report is for information only and not for submitting names for the ordinance work.

Extend Your Pedigree

Now having all of the surviving San Giovanni notarial records permits us to clarify our ancestral families who lived there. The next several issues will focus on these new ancestors and their families.

Important Note: To avoid duplication, names should be submitted for temple ordinances ONLY by the designated family representative for each immigrant family: Boyd Cardon for the Cardon surnames; Judy Melton for Rivoire surnames, myself for Malan surnames. If you wish to participate in this work, please coordinate and cooperate with us.

NOTE: The names of direct ancestors appear in **bold**. Abbreviations used: abt = about; b = born; bet = between; bur = buried; dec = deceased; md = married; prob = probably; wd = will dated; wid = widow(er); PP = Piedmont Project is source of particular information.

We present first a brief overview of the connection to the particular family, followed by a summary of the members of each family so far known on that line. Again: **Temple work for these is to be coordinated with Boyd Cardon.**

New Cardon Ancestors

According to the Piedmont Project, Anne OLIVET, b abt 1695/6 or 1699, d 1765, md Daniel JOUVE. Her parents were reported to be Jean OLIVET and Marie MALAN. However, in our Issue Number 10 (Spring 1997), we presented documentary evidence that her mother's name was also Anne, not Marie.

Gioanni OLLIVETTO, b prob abt 1605, wd 1630 [year of many deaths from the Plague] but lived years after; d by 1656; md prob abt 1629. He md (2) by 1655 Giudit [Judith] - ; they had one son Ludovico-Antonio, b perhaps abt 1655.

Maria PARISA, b abt 1609; d bet 1648-1654.

1. Pietro, b prob abt 1630, prob d bef 1656; may have md Gioanna DANNA.
2. Anna, aged 20 and more in 1656 so prob b abt 1634; md Gioanni MONERA.
3. **Daniele**, above; md **Margarita MARAUDA**.
4. Antonio, b abt 1642 (he and younger sisters were all minors but over 7 in 1656), d 1700?; md (1) abt 1670 Maria MALANOTO (d by 1675); md (2) by 1676 Cattarina DANNA; md (3) by 1698 Madalena GAIJ [GAY]; 3 children.
5. Margarita, b abt 1644, wd 1696; md Francisco

PELLENCHIONE.

6. Cattarina, b abt 1646.

7. Susanna, age prob abt 8 in 1656, so b abt 1648.

Pietro OLLIVETTO, b prob abt 1571, liv 1626, d by 1630; md abt 1595. Younger than his wife, as she was twice widow before marrying him.

Margarita -, b prob abt 1567; md (1) unnamed, by whom she had Maria (who md Daniele DANNA bef 1631); md (2) Bartholomeo NAZEROTTO, by whom she had Pietro and Daniele; d by 1631.

1. Cattarina, b abt 1596; md 1616 Giovanni MALLANO son of dec Daniele; 1 child.

2. Anna, b prob abt 1600, d by 1656; md (1) bef 1626 Paolo REVELLINO (d 1630 of the Plague), md (2) abt 1631 Francesco GOUANTA.

However, experience shows that when others cannot find the mother/wife's name, they proceed to have ordinances performed as "Mrs. [husband's name]. To avoid duplication by several descendants in this manner, we'll do it.
