A Very Distant Cousin

Some weeks ago, I received a letter from a man of Waldensian descent, Marcelo Bertinat, who lives in Argentina. (A few years after our LDS Waldensian ancestors migrated to the U.S., a severe drought afflicted the Valleys. A large number migrated to Argentina.) He hoped I could help him find his ancestors.

Marcelo is not LDS, but at the local Family History Center he had used the IGI and AncestralFile, in addition to what had been passed down in his family, to trace his lines back to the Valleys. Our work in the notarial records has been very useful in helping him extend his pedigree.

Who is he related to? Almost all of us, for his ancestry includes these surnames: Benech, Berger, Bertin, Bonnet, Catre, Coisson, Durand, Durand-Canton, Favette, Gardiol, Gaudin, Goss, Jourdan, Jouve, Lantaret, Long, Malan, Mirot, Musset, Odin, Pasquet, Pasquet-Pagnon, Pavarin, Pelenc, Peyrot, Rage, Roman, Rostan, Salvageto, Stringat, and Tourn. He descends from several Cardon, Malan, and Stalle ancestors.

NOTE: Waldensian wills generally list children *by gender, then by birth order* (typically, the girls first). Land transactions list children in order of their rights in the particular holding, and siblings without rights are not listed at all.

The analysis reported hereis made within the framework on the Piedmont Project and evidence from documents.

New Cardon Ancestors

We present first a brief overview of the connection to the particular line, followed by a listing of the members of each family so far known on that line. Again: **Temple work for these is to be fully coordinated with Boyd Cardon.**

The Piedmont Project shows Sidrac MALAN b abt 1669, d bef 25 May 1728, who md Lucie Goss and had eleven children, including the Cardon ancestor Paul, who md Marthe SARRET in 1728. Sidrac was the son of Jean (Italian: Giovanni) and Esther, though her maiden name was confounded. And the report that Jean was the son of a Barthelemy was wrong.

Extend Your Pedigree

Now having all of the surviving San Giovanni notarial records permits us to clarify our ancestral families who lived there. The next several issues will focus on these new families.

Important Note: To avoid duplication, names should be submitted for temple ordinances ONLY by the designated family representative for each immigrant family: Boyd Cardon for the Cardon surnames; Judy Melton for Rivoire surnames, myself for Malan surnames. If you wish to participate in this work, please coordinate and cooperate with us so we can proceed in unity and accuracy.

Paulo GOSSO [French: **Paul GOSS**], PP gives birth as estimated at 1648, but *Esuli* gives 1638. He was married before his father-in-law's will (22 Dec 1654), so probably married that year. His own will was dated 21 Oct 1697 and he died on 7 Nov that year. His father was another **Paulo**, who was d by 1657. In an act in San Giovanni dated 1658, he is described as being of Bubiana, a town on the plain. Coisson states that Goss is found at San Giovanni as early as 1519, but very few Goss references are found there before 1655; those few Goss families are said to be from Dronero, or from Vars in Dauphine (France). Further research at Bubiana, Dronero, and Vars is needed.

Ludovica BENECHIO [Louise BENECH], b prob also abt 1635. She died in 1686, a martyr at Saluzzo.

Order of the children's birth is uncertain. The sequence and estimated dates shown below reflect the general order shown in surviving documents, balanced with known dates.

IMPORTANT NOTE: When the wife/mother's name is unknown, it is generally recommended to leave the information blank. However, experience shows that when others cannot find the mother/wife's name, they proceed to have ordinances performed as "Mrs. [husband's name]." To avoid duplication by several descendants in this manner, the family representative will have the work done as "Mrs. [husband's name]."
