The Forneron Family

In our last issue, we noted that the Cardons, the Malans, and the Rivoires all descend from the Forneron family.

The Cardons have two Forneron lines. The first descends from a Philippe (Filippo), born about 1666. He is undoubtedly the Filippo, son of Bartholomeo, who appears in San Secondo records. This Bartholomeo married Margarita Constantino (daughter of Giacobo); he was son of an earlier Filippo, who was son of another Bartholomeo.

The second Cardon Forneron line is discussed later.

The Rivoires also have two Forneron descents. The first is from a Captain Jean, born about 1663, son of another Jean. These men also appear in the San Secondo records. The father Jean had been dead 18 years in 1669, and his widow Maria died in 1660. We haven't yet connected this line to the other Forneron line.

The second Rivoire Forneron line is also the second Cardon Forneron line, and the Malan line as well.

The Malans descend from Filippo, the grandfather of the Cardons' first Phillip or Filippo, noted above. Martha, daughter of this earlier Filippo, married Paulo Gardiolo; they were parents of Barthelemy Gardiol, ancestor of the Cardons, and of Paul Gardiol. This Paul married Marguerite Sarret; they were ancestors of both Malans and Rivoires.

In short, the Malans and Rivoires descend from Martha, and the Cardons descend from her brother Barthelemy.

They had another brother, Daniel, who played an important role in Waldensian society as the exile unfolded. Daniel was the notary for the village. When the duke's troops overpowered the valleys in 1686, Daniel was taken prisoner and, to save the lives of his wife and children, was forced to guide the ducal armies through the more remote areas. The results were devastating, as virtually all the Waldensians were killed or imprisoned, where thousands died of exposure, hunger, and disease.

After the Glorious Return, the survivors held no hard feelings toward Daniel, understanding his situation. He was elected to office in the village, proof of no animosity toward him.

Daniel left an account of the 1686 persecution. As he had witnessed much of the devastation, he was an eye witness. The account has been published in the *Bulletin de la Societe d'Histoire Vaudoise*, number 39, September 1918. The article is in French, the language Daniel spoke and wrote.

Those who desire a copy of the article can find the *Bulletin* in the Family History Library in Salt Lake City. The call number is Europe 945 F25b.

Those away from the Salt Lake area should be able to request a photocopy, although the Library may require you to complete a request form. The name of the article is, "Le Notaire Daniel Forneron," and you'll need to include the full name of the of the journal (Bulletin de la Societe d'Histoire Vaudoise), the number of the issue (39), the date (September 1918), and the pages to be copied (5-18).

Or, your nearest good library should be able to request it for you through the Interlibrary Loan system. (The FHL won't loan it this way, but about a half-dozen other libraries hold copies of the *Bulletin*.)
