Our Roman Families

At least three of the Waldensian emigrant families to the Western U.S. had ancestors named **Roman**.

CARDON: Marthe GAUDIN (born 1833, died 1920; wife of John Paul CARDON) was 2nd-great-granddaughter of (Elder) Philippe ROMAN (born abt 1698, died 1774) & of Marthe FORNERON. This Philippe was son of (Capt.) Philippe ROMAN (born abt 1654, died 1724) and his wife Suzanne FORNERON (born 1658, died 1728).

MALAN: Pauline COMBE (born 1805, died 1864; immigrant, wife of John Daniel MALAN) was 4th-great-granddaughter of Maria ROMAN, wife of Filippe FORNERON.

RIVOIRE: Judith GAUDIN (born 1829, died 1869; wife of Pierre RIVOIRE, the immigrant) was 3rd-great-granddaughter of Anne ROMAN (born 1671, d 1741; wife of (Elder) Pierre GAY).

For all three groups of descendants, we summarize here the San Secondo and Pramollo notarial records.

Other branches do appear in the records, as do the ancestors of the spouses listed below. We leave it to the family researchers to explore those lines.

For each family below, the father is listed first, then the mother; the children are numbered. For some, more work in the records is needed to establish the proper birth order of the children.

Please note that families marked * have already been submitted for temple work. For others, please coordinate with your family researcher (see page 4).

Abbreviations used: abt - about; b - born; bef = before; ch = children; dec = deceased; md = married; prob = probably; wd = will dated. **Direct ancestors** of all three families are in **bold**.

Martara [Martha] BOURNE, b prob abt 1580; d bef 1661; md (2) Antonio BIENATO.

- 1. Maria, b abt 1601, poss a twin; md 1621 Filippo FORNERON (wd 4 Jun 1668); 5 ch, incl.Martha FORNERON, who md Paulo GARDIOL. (This is the MALAN line.)
- 2. Catterina, b abt 1601, poss a twin; md 1621 Paulo FORNERON [brother of Filippo, above]; 4 children.
- 3. Madalena, b abt 1602; d bef 27 Jan 1661; md (1) 1622 Giacomo BIENATO; (2) Daniele PASQUET.
- 4. Daniele (above); md Anna GARDIOL.

The Cardon Sarret Line

The Piedmont Project shows Martha SARRET, b abt 1707, wife of Paul MALAN. These two are ancestors *both* to Anne JOUVE (b 1764, d 1815), wife of Jean CARDON (ancestors of the immigrant Philippe CARDON), *and* to Marthe MALAN (b 1762, d 1838), wife of Jean Barthelemy TOURN.

The following summarizes details gleaned from the San Secondo and Pramollo notarial records.

These families still need to have dates estimated before being submitted for temple ordinances.

Please coordinate your interest with Boyd Cardon (see page 4) to avoid duplication of effort.

RIVOIRE - San Secondo Vol 124

Quittance: Siblings Catterina (wife of dec Paulo ROBERTO), Margarita (wife of Michele PERONELLO) & Giacomo, children of dec Michele & Gioanna RIVOIRO. (27 March 1668)

Settlement of Dispute: Martha, wife of Giacomo RIVOIRO, dau of dec PeijretoCARDONE. (9 Apr 1669)

In the Valleys...

Visiting the Waldensian Valleys was a magnificent experience. More than thirty people, from five states, of Malan descent, including at least two also of Cardon descent, attended the International Malan Reunion. Total attendance was 130 people from seven countries, speaking six different languages.

Some of us climbed Mt. Brigham, also called the Rock of Prophecy. We stood where Elder Lorenzo Snow dedicated the land and where he prayed for, and received, permission to heal his landlord's dying son. That opened the doors to the gospel for our Waldensian ancestors.

We also visited the home of the John Daniel Malan family before the emigrated. This is also where they lodged the missionaries, providing them protection.

And of course we visited the Waldensian museums

and the Waldensian archives, as well as the village of Rora, home to some Cardon and Malan ancestors.

My wife and I spent a half-day with our researcher, Giovanni Cena and his wife. We toured the State Archives, which house the notarial records. I held in my hands two volumes, including the volume for 1615-1616, containing records of Cardon, Malan, and Rivoire ancestors, written by the hand of the notary who personally knew those people.

If you are able to visit the Valleys, first contact Flora Ferrero. LDS and of Waldensian descent, Flora lives there and speaks excellent English. She knows the sites. Her address: Borgata Bocchilardo 1, 10063 Pomaretto (TO), Italy.
