CORRECTION: Cardon MALAN Ancestors

In our last issue, we made an error. In the Cardon's Malan ancestry chart, person #224 is Barthelemy MALAN, not TURIN. Husband of Cattarina MICOLAY, his son was #112.

BEUS Entries at Pinasca

Michael is a traditional name among the ancestors of the Beus family that immigrated to Utah. We are finding several Beus entries in the notarial records, including some Michaels (French: Michel; Italian: Michele). The Italian form of the surname, *Bosio*, is used of course.

Early records include a Michele Bosio, whose father Bartolomeo was dead by 1622. Another Michele, with his brother Gioanni-Antonio, sons of Matteo (dead by 1615) and his wife Margarita. Additional research should tell which (if either) is the actual Beus ancestor and permit us to prepare names for the temple.

CARDON DIRECT LINE EXTENDED TO 1500S!

After much research, meditation, and consultation we have now extended the Cardon line further than the Piedmont Project!

In 1993, Marriner Cardon published a treatise on "The Search for Jean Cardon." He was able to extend the Cardon line back 2 generations. He raised some questions: 1. What is our relationship with a martyr at the Easter-time massacre in 1655 named Daniel Cardon of Roccapiatta? 2. What is our relationship with Jean and Daniel Cardon, brothers who participated in the Glorious Return(G.R.) in 1689? With the help of notary and Exile records, the Jalla genealogy, and Ron Malan these questions are answered!

Marriner's conjecture that there are two direct grandfathers named Jean is correct! Daniel Cardon, the martyr, is a brother of our direct ancestor, Jean. What a legacy!

Furthermore, we have been able to extend the Cardon line back three more generations and fill in the names of many of the spouses and siblings. Here is the pedigree chain beginning with our direct Phillip, who immigrated to America.

Abbreviation Key: G.R. = Glorious Return; RP = Roccapiatta; * = new descendent or person
