EXTEND YOUR PEDIGREE: CARDON BELLION LINES

Our January 2000 and December 2000 issues presented the Cardons' MALAN ancestors. Jean/Gioanni MALAN married Ester; her burial record calls her Ester GARCIN, but her husband Jean's will and her father's will prove conclusively that she was daughter of Michele BELLION and his wife Isabella. We now present her ancestry.

In addition to notarial records, we're helped in this effort by ducal records that predate surviving notarial records. These aren't readily available to us and few Waldensian families appear in them sufficiently to form a pedigree. But a Waldensian minister, Jean Jalla, was related to this family and researched the lines in the ducal records. The Appia family, involved below, was also featured in two articles appearing the Waldensian Historical Society's journal, *Bollettino della Società di Studi Valdesi*, number 126 (1969), written by Beatrice Appia. (This journal is available in the Family History Library in Salt Lake City.)

We use our normal abbreviations: abt = about, b = born, d = died, md = married, wd = will dated. Direct ancestors are shown in **bold**. *Please do NOT submit these names for temple ordinances*; if you wish to assist, please contact Boyd Cardon at BYU-Idaho [Ricks College].

In *PFO Report* No. 28, Feb 2001, I gave the parents of Maria GODIN. Key: Double the number to get the father and add one to get the mother. SS= San Secondo PR = Pramollo. I repeat from Maria as number 1 to the newly found ancestors.
