Another Cardon Line: PASQUET-PAGNON

In *PFO Report* issue 28 (February 200), I gave the wife, heretofore unknown of our direct ancestor Jean Cardon (b 1630 and died in exile in 1686) as Anna Pasquet-Pagnon (b abt 1634). I now give her ancestors.

PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT ANY OF THESE NAMES FOR TEMPLE WORK. IT IS NOW BEING DONE.

Key: Double the number to get the father and add one to get the mother. SS= San Secondo PR = Pramollo. Anna will be number one of the newly found ancestors.

EXTEND YOUR PEDIGREE

The Rivoire and the Cardon GAUDINS

NOTE: The Rivoires have several Gaudin lines; the Cardons have at least one. We now feature these lines.

One of the Rivoire ancestors was **Antoine GAUDIN**, born in 1724, dead by 1786; in 1749 he married Anne GAY.

This Antoine was son of another **Antoine GAUDIN** and his wife **Marguerite GAUDIN**.

This last Antoine was brother of the Cardons' ancestor **Marie GAUDIN** who married **Jean CARDON**. Antoine and Marie were children of a third **Antoine GAUDIN** and his wife **Martha** (see the Family Summaries below) .

In one notarial act, Martha's married name is given for her maiden name; but other acts, including her own father's will naming her and her husband, correct this mistake. Therefore, the following is a CORRECTION of this portion of the Cardon GAUDIN/ GODIN pedigree presented in the June 2001 issue, p. 3.

We gladly accede to the Waldensian convention of using the French form of surnames, important to them so as to distinguish Waldensian from other branches of the family. And, for this family, we accept the PP spelling "Gaudin" rather than "Godin" for the sake of consistency.

We use our normal abbreviations: abt = about, b = born, ch = child/children; d = died, *Esuli* = Armand-Hugon's *Gli Esuli Valdesi in Svizzera 1686-1690*; md = married, PP = Piedmont Project family group record; prob = probably; wd = will dated. Direct ancestors are shown in **bold**. *Please do NOT submit these names for temple ordinances*; if you wish to help, please contact Boyd Cardon or Judy Melton.

EXTEND YOUR PEDIGREE

A Second Rivoire GAUDIN Line

The **Antoine GAUDIN** (b 1724-d bef 1786) who began the pedigree in the prior GAUDIN lineage married **Marguerite GAUDIN**. We now present her

ancestry—which overlaps her husband's. We leave it to the Rivoire family to estimate birth and marriage dates on this line, guided by the estimated dates in the previous article and the occasional dates given below.

EXTEND YOUR PEDIGREE A Third Rivoire GAUDIN Line

The parents of the **Antoine GAUDIN** who began the first Gaudin line above were another **Antoine GAUDIN** and his wife **Marie GAUDIN**. We now present the ancestry of this **Marie**.

Wife not named in notarial records; the Rivoire family should check the *working draft* family group records of the PP and then the microfilmed christenings of their children; the names of the sponsors [godparents] should reveal at least the maiden surname of this wife and she can then be found.
