## EXTEND YOUR PEDIGREE Another Cardon Line: STALÉ ANCESTRY

It is refreshing and exhilarating to extend our lines and to do the essential ordinance work for our ancestors! The notary records are of great value and very helpful. Please continue to financially support the PFO. My thanks to Ron Malan for some good hints.

### **Brief history of the Cardon-Stalé family in America**

The Philippe Cardon family immigrated to America in 1854 and came by wagon to Utah. In 1856 the Jean Pierre Stalé family with the aid of the Perpetual Emigration Fund came with the Ellsworth Handcart Company to Utah. Jean Pierre Stalé died and was buried

along the Platte River in Sweet Water, Wyoming. Philippe Cardon sent his two sons, John Paul and Louis Phillip, to Salt Lake to bring the Stalé family and other Waldensian saints to Ogden. Philippe took Jean Pierre Stalé's widow Jeanne Marie Gaudin-Moise as a second wife. Louis Phillip took Suzette Stalé as a second wife. Hence a Cardon father and son married a Stalé mother and daughter! The siblings of Susette were Barthelemi Daniel, Marie (md Elihu Warren) and Marguerite (md Henry Barker).

### **Research to extend the Stalé line**

The notary records, along with the record of the Exiles in Switzerland, give us information to extend the Stalé line. The Piedmont Project ends with Jean Stalé b. 1666 and wife Marguerite Chanforan b 1664 both from Angrogna, Torino, Italy. *Gli Esuli Valdesi in Svizzera (Waldensian Exiles in Switzerland)* gives a different birth date for Jean b. 1664 and Marguerite b.1664 and the order of their first three children: Marie b 1685, Jean b 1688, and Marthe abt 1690 in Brandenburg. However, to resolve this is not the purpose of this article. What is given is the name of Jean's uncle, Paul Stalé b 1630 and his wife Marguerite b 1642. Also, the names of Marguerite Chanforan's parents: Daniel b 1627 and Marthe b 1630, with a daughter Marie b 1659.

With these clues and inspiration, I was able to find the parents of Jean and Paul Stalé. In addition I was able to extend the Chanforan line and find the surname of Marthe, Daniel's wife.

**Key:** All people were born in Angrogna, Torino, Italy unless noted otherwise. SG = San Gioanni, Torino, Italy. PP = Piedmont Project. When given, *Esuli* dates are used, as they were recorded in the person's own lifetime. All surnames are given in French, the Waldensian preference.

*Double the number of the person to get the father, add one to get the mother (e.g., the father of #3 is #6 and the mother is #7).*

An \* in front of a name indicates a newly identified

ancestor.

## The GAY ("GUY") Ancestry of Cardons and of Rivoires

*NOTE: In French—the language of the Waldensians at the time—the surname GAI is pronounced GUY.*

NOTE: In our August 2001 issue (Number 31), we presented an outline of some GAY lines, but without including estimated dates. We include them now.

The Cardons descend from **Marthe GAY** who married Daniel PASQUET. The Piedmont Project (PP) estimated her birth as about 1668, but the parish registers provided no further information about her.

The Rivoires, on the other hand, descend from **(Elder) Pierre GAY**, estimated in the Piedmont Project to have been born in 1674, but as shown below must have been older than that; he died in 1744, the husband of Anne ROMAN. This (Elder) Pierre was son of another (Elder) Pierre, whose birth the PP estimated as about 1642; as his son Pierre (Peiretto) had to have been born before the PP estimate of 1674, so also the father Pierre was

also older.

Because these lines ultimately intersect, we diverge from our usual approach. Instead of beginning with the family closest to the immigrant ancestor, we begin here with the earliest known generation. This simplifies the presentation and should therefore reduce confusion. NOTE: This surname generally appears as GAIJ in the records; we use the the French form, which is the Waldensian preference.

We use our normal abbreviations: abt = about, b = born, ch = child/children; d = died, md = married, wd = will dated. *Esuli* = *Gli Esuli Valdesi in Svizzera 1686-1690* [*Waldensian Exiles in Switzerland 1686-1690*]; *BSHV* = *Bulletin de la Societe d'Histoire Vaudoises* [*Bulletin of the Waldensian Historical Society*].

Direct ancestors are shown in **bold**.

- **Maria** b 1683 (*BSHV* 37:91); placed by Duke in the monastery in **Aosta Valley**
