# EXTEND YOUR PEDIGREE Another Cardon Line: BERGER ANCESTRY

#### by Boyd Cardon

My research begins with the Berger line (in Italian: Bergero) mentioned in the *PFO Report*, Spring 1995 No. 5 and Fall 1996 No. 8.

The Piedmont Project family group record gives the names of the sons of Jacques Berger as Joseph, Jean and Daniel. It also names Jacques' brother Pietro. The notary records give us the name of a daughter, Maria. With this information and the Waldensian naming pattern, I looked for a Gioanni (Jean) who married a Maria and had sons Giacomo (Jacques) and Pietro. I discovered the connection in the notary

records. With careful thought and prayer I have extended the Berger line back two more generations. Therefore, we find the identity of Jacques' parents, grandparents, and great-grandparents.

Key: b = born; md = married; bro = brother; dau = daughter; dec = deceased; fu = child of deceased (followed by the parent's name); NR = notary records; PP = Piedmont Project family group record forms, film # 472233; FHLA = Family History Library, Main Archives [now housed in the Joseph Smith Memorial Building, East Wing 4th Floor]; Es = Gli Esuli Valdesi; bold = direct ancestor. Add one to the number to get the person's spouse; double the number to get the father.

I begin with (Elder) Jean Berger b abt 1668 as given in PP. The record only lists three sons. The NR give us another daughter Maria and her spouse.

## More on the CARDON AVONDET Line

Our March issue presented the Cardon AVONDET ancestry. We have begun receiving extractions from another series of records, a separate Valli di Perosa series. These reveal more about the Avondet family.

Family coordinators preparing Avondet families for temple ordinance work should update the information in our March 2002 issue with the following new details.

New information is in *italics* for your convenience.

Direct ancestors are in bold, as usual.

Will of Bartholomeo AVONDET son of deceased Lorenzo of Inverso Porte; wife Martha -; children Susanna (wife of Daniele BOUCHARD), Maria (wife of Filippo GODIN son of deceased Gioanni of Inverso Porte), Margarita, Lorenzo, and Filippo. NOTE: In our March issue, we estimated this Bartholomeo's birth as about 1617. (VPer vol 48 pg 28, 22 Apr 1670; daughter Susanna and her husband also mentioned in vol 49 pg 296)

Quittance: siblings *Martha* (wife of Bartholomeo AVONDET son of deceased Lorenzo) and Bartholomeo *CONSTANTIN* children of deceased Bartholomeo of Prarostino. (VPer 48:102, 22 Apr 1670)

Marriage settlement: siblings Susanna (wife of Daniele BOUCHARD of Inverso Porte), Lorenzo, and Gioanni AVONDET children of deceased **Bartholomeo** and **Martha** of Inverso Porte. (VPer 48:366, 22 Feb 1672)

Brothers Lorenzo and Gioanni AVONDET sons of dec. Bartholomeo are also mentioned, with Maddalena Avondet daughter of dec. Giacobo of Inverso Porte (a RIVOIRE relative). (VPer 49:572)

## More on the RIVOIRE AVONDET Line

In March we also presented the Rivoire **Avondet** line. The new Valli di Perosa series also reveals more about this Avondet family.

Purchase involving **Bartholomeo AVONDET** son of deceased **Giacomo** of Inverso Porte and the children of deceased Michele SAPPE of Inverso Porte. (VPer 49:293R, 16 May 1678)

Ratification involving Maddalena AVONDET dau. of deceased Giacobo of Inverso Porte, and brothers Lorenzo and Gioanni AVONDET sons of deceased Bartholomeo (Cardon ancestor and his brother). (VPer 49:572, 12 Jun 1681)

Purchase involving Giacomo AVONDET son of dec. Bartholomeo; brothers Paulo, Giacobo, and Bartholomeo AVONDET sons of dec Bartholomeo of Porte; dec Gioanni AVONDET son of deceased Antonio; and Margarita [?AVONDET], wife of Gioanni BOCHIA. (VPer 51:377, 14 May 1714)

# GAY (said "GUY") Revisions/Additions

In working through the information on my GAY (GUY) line, featured in the January 2002 *PFO Report*, Number 33, I found I could make a few minor changes, as well as add new information. I welcome any feedback on the following:

#### \*Gioanni GAY, b. abt. 1564:

I have re-estimated the birth of Barnaba Gay, son of Gioanni, from 1604 to about 1594. This may place Barnaba as child number two instead of number three, depending on how the Cardon's, who descend from Michele, work through their information.

### \*Barnaba GAY, (b. abt 1594) son of Gioanni, b abt. 1564:

I have rearranged the birth order of Barnaba's children as follows, as well as added information:

- Davide Gay, b abt 1622, md. Madalena Costantin, 1 son, Bartholomeo, born about 1645; Bartholomeo md Anna Sarrett, dau of Gioanni Sarrett by 1669
- Gioanni GAY, b abt 1629, md 1) by 1668 Gioanna Serro, who was b abt 1633 and died by 1673; md 2) Lidia Fornerone, dau of Giacomo by 1673; 1 dau, Margarita, b abt 1674, md Giacomo Paschetto, son of Gioanni Paschetto
- Susanna GAY, b abt 1633, md Peiretto Gardiol, son of Antonietto and Anna -.
- Margarita Gay (additional daughter), born about 1635. She appears in San Secondo Vol. 133, pg 70. No further information.
- Maria GAY, b abt 1637, md Filippo Sarrett by 1657, 5 children: Francesco, b abt 1658, md Margarita Bertalot by 1683 (2 daus, Maria, b abt

1684 and Anna Maria, b abt 1686); Anna, b abt 1660, md Gioanni Godin abt 1680; Margarita, b abt 1662, died between 1678 and 1694; Maria, b abt 1664, md Michele Cardon abt 1684; and Barnaba, b abt. 1666, md Sarra Peyrot (3 children: Filippo, b abt 1703, Gioanni, b abt 1706, Maria, b abt 1709).

- \*Pierre GAY, (b abt 1617), son of Matteo, b abt 1589, son of Gioanni b abt. 1564:
- Child #3, Gioanni, b abt 1646, still living in 1702, per San Secondo Vol 134, pg 88 R.
- Child #4, Barnaba, b abt 1648, md (1) by abt 1672, Catherine Combe-Magnot (three children: Peireto, b abt 1675, Susanna, b abt 1677, and Catherina, b abt 1679; all 3 children dead by 1699); md (2) aft 1684 to Anna Martina, dau of David and Maria Martina.
   Child #7, Anna, b abt 1654, (1) md unknown, but wd by 1686; dau Catherine who died in 1687, by first marriage; (2) md aft 1687 to Michele Bastie.

Please note that I have prepared temple work for all of the descendants of Gioanni Gay, born about 1564, EXCEPT for MICHELE GAY and his descendants. That work will be organized by Boyd Cardon, a direct descendant of Michele.

# A Correction: Cardon MARAUDE Line

In *PFO Report* Number 21, November 1999, we presented the Cardons' OLIVET line, including their MARAUDE line. Records found since then require the MARAUDE line to be fully reworked, as shown below.

Because the Malan family also descends from a branch of the Maraude family, some temple work has been completed.

Boyd Cardon will coordinate temple work for the remaing Cardon ancestors on the Maraude line.

Bartholomeo MARAUDE, in Number 21 (Nov 1999) estimated as b prob abt 1612, but more likely abt 1602, of Rora; prob md (1) name unknown, no known children; md (2) abt 1636; d 1648.

- (2) Madalena GONIN, b abt 1616, San Giovanni. Children:
- 1. Gioanni, b abt 1637, mayor 1684; md 1661 Cattarina BELLIONE; 6 children.
- 2. Giacomo, b abt 1640, d aft 1681; md by 1665 Maria PRASSUIT, wid of Pietro GONIN; 8 children
- 3. Maria, b abt 1642, d by 1668.
- 4. Margarita; md Daniele OLIVET.
- 5. Cattarina, b abt 1646; md Daniele BASTIE.
- 6. Bartholomeo, b abt 1648, d by 1668.

Gioanne MARAUDE, b abt 1575, Rora; according to Rev. Jean Jalla, he d 1625-1626; md abt 1599.

Mrs. Gioanne MARAUDE, b abt 1579.

*NOTE*: This is *NOT* "Anna PERRO" as reported in Number 21; she married a *different* Gioanni.

#### Children:

- 1. Bartolomeo (above); md Madalena GONIN.
- 2. Stefano, b abt 1604; wd 21 Mar 1649; md abt 1626 Cattarina ODIN dau of Stefano & Margarita; 3 children.

NOTE: Stefano's son Bartholomeo married Margarita GIGNOUS-JANAVEL, daughter of the famous Captain Josué JANAVEL and also sister of the Malans' ancestor Maria, who md Steffano BONNET. Jalla says Janavel's son-in-law was Jean, son of Stefano's brother Bartolomeo; but the notary records correct this, being very explicit.

- 3. Giacomo, b abt 1606; d abt 1655; md 1) abt 1628 Maria ODIN, sister to Cattarina above; md 2) 1640 Margarita BESSON dau of Gioanni-Battista; 1 dau by 1st wife; 5 children by 2nd wife, all 5 of them under age 14 in 1657.
- 4. Margarita, b abt 1610; md Giuseppe JOUVE (Malan ancestors).

Giaime MARAUDE, b abt 1548, of Rora; d bef 1611; md abt 1572.

Mrs. Giaime MARAUDE, b abt 1552, of Rora.

1. Gioanne (above); wife unknown so far.

Jacques MARAUDE, b abt 1519, of Rora; md abt 1543. On 22 Mar 1557, was one of 6 Waldensian from Rora ordered to appear in Turin to declare if the village was prepared to return to the Catholic Church. Jalla feels he may be the same as "Giaime" (Jacques in the local dialect) above, but Jalla also surmises that the 6 were village elders; it's unlikely that someone who was already an "elder" in 1557 to father children some twenty years later.
