The COLOMBAT Ancestry – of the Rivoires, the Bouchards, and the Clapiers

The earliest COLOMBAT in the Piedmont Project was **Michel COLOMBAT born abt 1663** “of Torre Pellice.” He and his wife Marie (maiden surname then unknown) had four children: **Jeanne** (b abt 1689—but we’ve changed it to abt 1691 as noted below), **André** (abt 1695), Marie (b and chr 1702 at Torre), and another Marie (b and chr 1705). The reason for the change in Jeanne’s estimated birth date lies in the mother’s Piedmont Project estimated birth date; we find no reason to have her marry so young when her second known child was born so much later.

The Bouchards and Clapiers descend from the daughter **Jeanne**; the Rivoires descend from the son **André**.

Although their last two children were born and christened at Torre, this family (like several others after the Exile) was not from this area originally. The notary records of Valli di Perosa, San Secondo, Pinasca, and Luserna San Giovanni permit us to develop the COLOMBAT pedigree as follows.

KEY: abt = about; b = born; bef = before; md = married; d = died

To find any person’s father, double that person’s number (example: father of # 2 = # 4); to find the mother, add 1 to the father’s number (example: mother of # 2 = # 5); abt = about; b = born; md = married; d = died. For added clarity, generations are double-spaced.

The FORQUIN Ancestry – of the Beuses, the Bouchards, and the Clapiers

The earliest FORQUIN in the Piedmont Project was **Jean FORQUIN born abt 1672**, who married **Madeleine BARET**. The notary records indicate that he was actually older than that and had been married previously, as shown below.

The Beuses descend from Jean and Madeleine's daughter **Jeanne (1711)**, who md Claude CLAPIER.

The Bouchards descend from Jean and Madeleine's son **Jacques (1698)**, who md Marie GAYDOU—actually, in fact, they descend from two of the children of Jacques and Marie: Jeanne (1769; md Francois BOUCHARD) and Jacques (1773; md Marire BOUDRAND or BOUNDRANDI).

The Clapiers descend from the son **Jean (1702)**, who md. Jeanne PEYRONEL.

Also had: Madeleine (1700) and Marie (1705).

The Cardon RAGE (said “Rahj”) Line

This report is prepared out of my profound gratitude to the Cardon family for their many years of support of our research project in the notary records. I hope it is an acceptable expression of that gratitude.

The surname RAGE has nothing at all to do with the English word “rage,” nothing to do with anger. Gedeone Rage is named more often than any other person in the Angrogna notary records, due to his profession: notary. It is supposed that he d early in 1630, a victim of the Bubonic Plague epidemic that swept through the Waldensian Valleys. Among its first and foremost victims were the doctors, the ministers, and the notaries—those called upon to assist the dying. It is unfortunate—and ironic for a notary—that he left no will. But the Plague hit suddenly and killed thousands. He was a great and highly respected man.

Temple ordinances have been completed for these people. Please do *not* resubmit them.

1. **Maria Rage** was b abt 1668, Angrogna, Torino, Italy. She d 8 Dec 1713, Angrogna. Maria md **Jean Stringat** on 12 Dec 1691, Angrogna. Jean was b 1662, San Giovanni, Torino, Italy.

Second Generation

2. **Daniele Rage** was b abt 1621, Angrogna; md abt 1645 in San Giovanni.
3. **Maria Peyrot** was b abt 1625 in San Giovanni.
In addition to Maria, they had Gedeone, David¹, Gioanni, and David².

Third Generation

4. **Gedeone Rage** was b abt 1570, Angrogna; md abt 1594.
5. **Maria Musset** was b abt 1576, of Angrogna.
In addition to Daniele, they had Andrea, Gioanni-Pietro, Paolo, Catterina, and Bartholomeo.
6. **Davide Peyrot** was b abt 1599, of San Giovanni, Torino, Italy, d after 15 Mar 1654; md abt 1624.
7. **Margarita Parise** was b abt 1604 of San Giovanni, Torino, Italy.
NOTE: Davide PEYROT and Margarita PARISE, and all their ancestors, are also MALAN ancestors.
In addition to Maria, they had Daniele abt 1627, Michele abt 1631, and Jean abt 1638.

Fourth Generation

8. **Andrea Rage** was b abt 1545, of Angrogna; d before 1620; md abt 1569.
9. **Mrs. Andrea Rage** was b abt 1549, of Angrogna.
10. **Giorgio Musset** was b abt 1554 in Angrogna; d 1630 during the Bubonic Plague epidemic; md abt 1575.
NOTE: Giorgio md (2) 1582, Magarita GIRARD; they are MALAN ancestors.
11. (1) **Mrs. Margarita Musset** was b abt 1558, of Angrogna, Torino, Italy. She d abt 1581.

12. **Daniele Peyrot** was b abt 1568, of San Giovanni; d after 3 Aug 1620; md abt 1592, of San Giovanni.
13. **Maria Jaime** was b abt 1572 of Campiglione, Torino, Italy.
They also had Vuetto abt 1593, Gabriele abt 1594, Catterina abt 1596, Anna abt 1598, Bartholomeo abt 1602, and Susanna abt 1605.
14. **Michele Parise** was b abt 1577 of San Giovanni; d before 20 Nov 1632; md. abt 1601 of San Giovanni.
15. **Cattarina Arnoul-Camus** was b abt 1581 of San Giovanni; d before 2 May 1635.
They also had Umberto abt 1602, Pietro abt 1606, Giovanni abt 1608, and Madalena abt 1610.

Fifth Generation

20. **Micahale Musset** was b abt 1527 of Angrogna; d before 29 Sep 1611; md abt 1551.
21. **Mrs. Micahale Musset** was b abt 1531 of Angrogna.
Also had Gioanni¹ abt 1552, Antonio 1556, Gioanna 1558, Maria 1560, Catterina 1562, Pietro 1564, Samuelle abt 1566, and Gioanni² abt 1568.
24. **Vuetto or Ugone Peyrot** was b abt 1541, San Giovanni; d before 1612; md abt 1565 of San Giovanni.
25. **Mrs. Vuetto or Ugone Peyrot** was b abt 1545 of San Giovanni.
Also had Gioheto abt 1566, Elliseo abt 1570, Gioanni abt 1572, Lucia abt 1574, and Margarita abt 1576.
26. **Gabriele Jaime** was b abt 1543 of Campiglione, Torino, Italy; d before 18 Jun 1615; md abt 1567.
27. **Mrs. Gabriele Jaime** was b abt 1547 of Campiglione.
28. **Umbertino "Bertino" Parise** was b abt 1546 of San Giovanni; d abt 4 Jan 1617 San Giovanni; . abt 1570.
29. **Mrs. Umbertino Parise** was b abt 1550 of San Giovanni.
In addition to Michelle, they had Emanuelle abt 1579, Daniele abt 1582, and Pietro abt 1586.
30. **Pietro Arnoul-Camus** was b abt 1552 of San Giovanni; d abt 28 Mar 1616; md abt 1576 in Angrogna.
31. **Gioanina Malan** was b abt 1556 in Angrogna.
In addition to Catterina, they had Maria abt 1577 and Madalena abt 1579 (also a MALAN ancestor).

Sixth Generation

40. **Gioanetto Musset** was b abt 1500 of Angrogna; d before 1599; md abt 1524.
41. **Mrs. Gioanetto Musset** was b abt 1504 of Angrogna.
They also had Giorgio abt 1525, Antonio abt 1531, and Giacobino abt 1533 (also a MALAN ancestor).
48. **Gioheto Peyrot** was b abt 1514 of San Giovanni; d before 1565; md abt 1538 of San Giovanni.
49. **Mrs. Gioheto Peyrot** was b abt 1518 of San Giovanni.
They also had Antonio abt 1539, Chiaffredo abt 1543, Guglielmino abt 1547, and Domenico abt 1549.
56. **Emanuele Parise** was b abt 1515 of San Giovanni; d after 1597; md abt 1539.
57. **Mrs. Emanuele Parise** was b abt 1519 of San Giovanni, Torino, Italy.
In addition to Umbertino, they had Gioanni abt 1540, Chiaffredo abt 1548, and Pietro abt 1550.
60. **Gioanni Arnoul-Camus** was b abt 1527 of Angrogna d before 9 Sep 1611; md . abt 1551.
61. **Mrs. Gioanni Arnoul-Camus** was b abt 1531 of Angrogna.
In addition to Pietro, Gioanni Arnoul-Camus and his wife also had Maria abt 1554.
62. **Gioanni Malan** was b abt 1531 of Angrogna; d after 1594; md abt 1555 of Angrogna.
63. **Mrs. Gioanni Malan** was b abt 1535 of Angrogna, Torino, Italy.

Seventh Generation

80. **Georges Musset** was b abt 1473 of Angrogna; d after 1542; md abt 1497, of Angrogna.
81. **Mrs. Margarita Musset** was b abt 1477 of Angrogna.
In addition to Gioanetto, they had Pietro abt 1498.
96. **Antoine Peyrot-Malan** was b abt 1480 of Peyrots, San Giovanni; md abt 1504 of Peyrots.
97. **Mrs. Antoine Peyrot-Malan** was b abt 1484 of Peyrots, Torino, Italy.
In addition to Gioheto, they had Guigone abt 1506.
112. **Jean Imbert-Parise** was b abt 1478 in Angrogna; abt 1502, Angrogna.
113. **Mrs. Jean Imbert-Parise** was b abt 1482 of Angrogna.
In addition to Emanuelle, they had Bertino.

Eighth Generation

160. **Pierre Musset** was b abt 1446, Angrogna; md abt 1470 of Angrogna.
161. **Mrs. Pierre Musset** was b abt 1450 of Angrogna.
192. **Guigone Peyrot** was b abt 1455 of Peyrots, San Giovanni; d after 1509; md abt 1479 of Peyrots.
193. **Mrs. Guigone Peyrot** was b abt 1459 of Peyrots.
224. **Mr. Imbert-Parise** was b abt 1453, Angrogna; d before 1503; md abt 1477, Angrogna.
225. **Mrs. Johannina Imbert-Parise** was b abt 1457 of Angrogna. She d after 1503.
